Chairman's Report

it is a pleasure to report on the happenings in our community over the last 12 months. Huntington Park is still a very desirable area to invest and live in and by maintaining a clean and tidy environment, our investment can only enjoyed and appreciated.

However last year, our dreams were dashed when Kainga Ora (Housing New Zealand) acquired the old Guy property on Guys Rad, and decided to build 46 Housing new units on the property. After the AGM meeting last August, our association underwent a reorganization of its core members. Since then, all core members have been diligently following up on this matter. At the same time, we have organized events such as the Christmas Lights Competition and Neighbour Day to enhance connections among everyone. These are some of the achievements we have collectively attained over the past year:

1. We have upgraded the community's Facebook and website.
2. We organized the Christmas Lights Competition in Dec 2023 and Neighbour Day in March 2024
3. We secured Christmas community discounts from Mitre10 for everyone.
4. We provided regular colour newsletter flyers.
5. Regarding the community housing project, we have maintained active and ongoing communication with the Prime Minister's Office, the local board, and relevant agencies such as Kainga Ora. The biggest breakthrough was obtaining the direct contacts for the community if any problems regarding the housing project within our community

However, there is still a lot of follow-up work that requires everyone's collective effort and attention:

1. Setting up neighborhood support
2. Applying for the Crime Prevention Fund
3. Installing CCTV cameras if possible
4. Addressing the issue of broken yellow lines
5. Parking issues on Guys Road as tenants move into the community housing

Therefore, we need more neighbors to join us and contribute their efforts and the time is now.




