#### EASTERN BUSWAY UPDATES

Botany Town Centre bus stop upgrade
We would like to let you know that on Monday 12
August upgrade work will start on the Botany Town
Centre bus stop and adjacent road and footpaths.
New bus shelters with customer information and signage will also be installed.

A temporary bus stop will be available at the south end of Botany Town Centre by the Rockshop from 12 August until late November while the upgrade work takes place. Signage will be in place to guide bus customers to the temporary stop.
